Introduction

As a website administrator, you can provide your site's users with the ability to search the SMART Exchange™ website from your website by inserting the SMART Exchange search widget into an existing web page.

The SMART Exchange search widget will display on your web page similar to the image below.

You can configure the SMART Exchange search widget to display in any one of 23 languages.

Instructions

Adding widget to a web page

To add the SMART Exchange search widget code to a web page

1. In an HTML or text editor, open the HTML file to which you want to add the search widget.
2. Copy the block of code below. Paste the code between the `<body> </body>` tags on the page. The location in the code determines where the search widget will appear on the web page.

3. In the `<noscript>` code section shown below, replace the text between the two `<label>` tags (highlighted below) with the appropriate text from the **Message text** column in the **Language codes** table below.

4. Save the HTML file and open it in a browser to view the widget in the new language.

Which browsers and operating systems does the SMART Exchange search widget support?

What DOCTYPE is required to use the SMART Exchange search widget?

The SMART Exchange search widget will work with all DOCTYPES available in the W3C recommendations. These include:

- HTML5
- HTML 4.01 Strict
- HTML 4.01 Transitional
- HTML 4.01 Frameset
- XHTML 1.0 Strict
- XHTML Transitional 1.0
- XHTML 1.1

If you do not currently use a DOCTYPE at the top of your HTML page, you may use the HTML5 DOCTYPE: `<!DOCTYPE HTML>`

Will the SMART Exchange search widget append anything to my website's URL once the user clicks on the search button?

No. The widget uses a form POST, which does not append anything to your website's URL.

What does the `<noscript>` tag do?

The text inside the `<noscript>` tag will only show up if the customer's browser does not have JavaScript enabled.

Are there any accessibility features in the SMART Exchange search widget?

Yes, there are some accessibility features such as headings, and labels for input fields.

Does the widget support right-to-left (RTL) languages (e.g., Arabic)?

Yes. If you have set the language to a SMART Exchange supported RTL language in the `<script>` section, the widget will automatically display in RTL format.

Will the SMART Exchange search widget work with UTF-8 characters (e.g., Chinese, Russian, Arabic)?

Yes.
