

McCarron is 2017-18 Board President for the Minnesota Administrators for Special Education

Diane McCarron, Director of Special Education at SWWC Service Cooperative, will serve as President of the Board of Directors for the Minnesota Administrators for Special Education (MASE). McCarron served as President-Elect during the 2016-17 school year.

As President, McCarron will preside at the annual business meeting of MASE and at the meetings of the Board of Directors. She will act for MASE between annual meetings by communicating important actions with the other board officers. She will also represent MASE at meetings of other groups where MASE representation is desired or required.



McCarron has worked as a Director of Special Education at SWWC since 2007.
